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A REVIEW ON TOXICOLOGICAL ASPECTS OF HEAVY METALS USED IN COSMETICS

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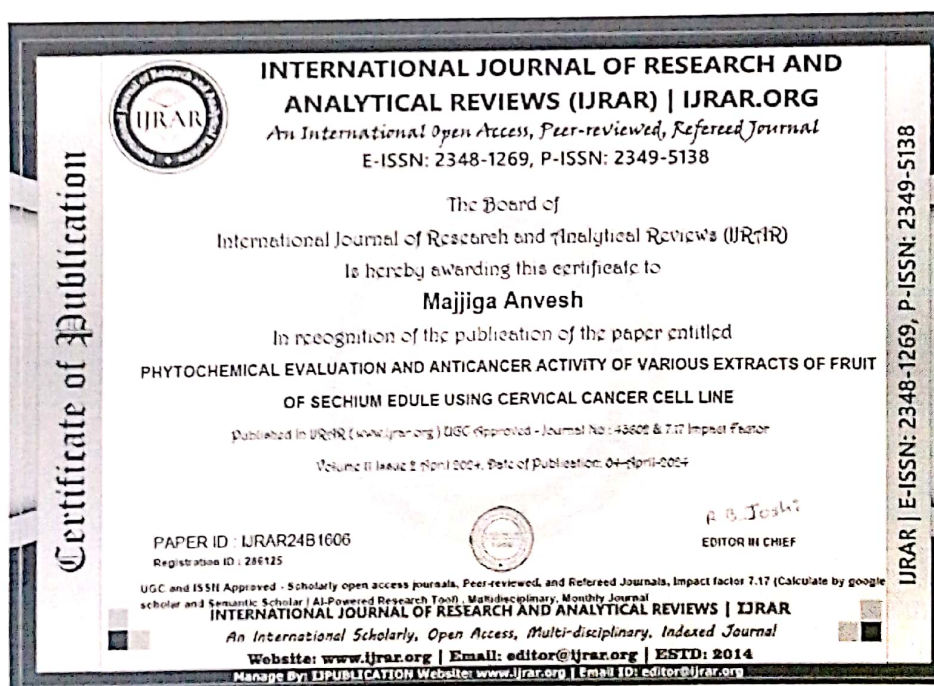
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ABSTRACT

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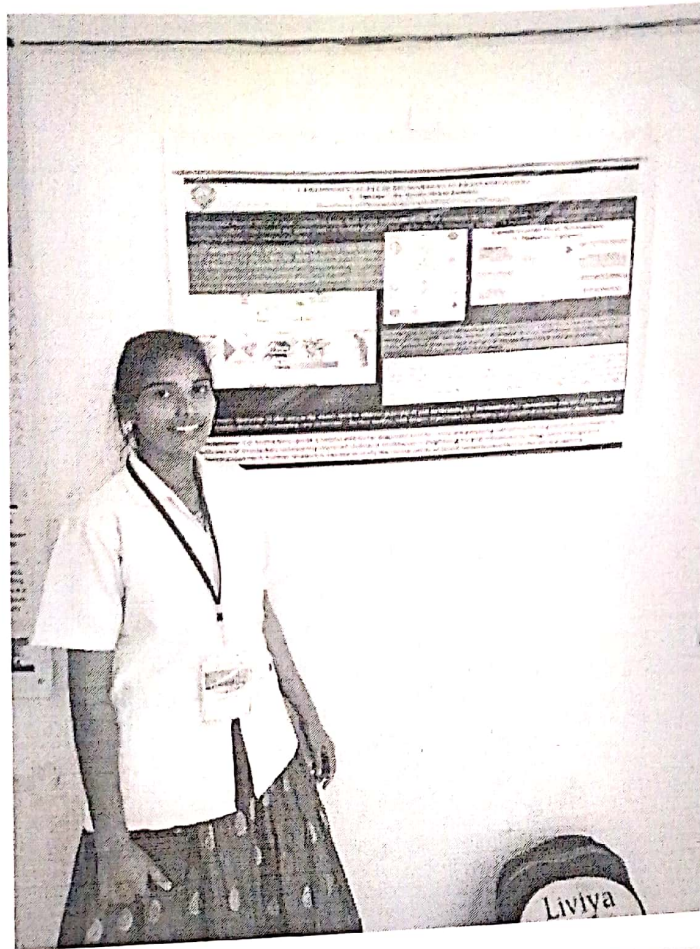
